### Did you know?

Warwick Castle was built as a motte-and-bailey castle by William the Conqueror in 1068. This original wooden structure was rebuilt in stone in the 12<sup>th</sup> Century. The current façade of the castle dates to the 14<sup>th</sup> Century when it was redone during the 100 Years' War. In 1604 King James I gifted the castle to the Earls of Warwick who kept it in the family for over 400 years, until it was sold to the Tussauds Entertainment group in 1978. The castle is now a fully interactive medieval castle!
